What is a GIF?

GIF stands for Graphic Interchange Format. A GIF is essentially a compressed video, meaning it takes up less room on your computer. It also plays continuously, where as a video comes to an end.

Download GIF

- 1. Download GIF from the London's Air Ambulance webpage. This should appear in the download bar at the bottom of the screen or in your Downloads folder.
- 2. Open the GIF and save somewhere where you will easily find it.

How to use on Facebook

- 1. Head to the 'create post' section.
- 2. Choose the add photo/video option (green photo icon).
- 3. Select GIF from where you have saved it on your computer.
- 4. Once loaded the GIF will appear as a video icon.
- 5. Add text to your post and most importantly, <u>don't forget to add your fundraising page link</u>.

How to use on Twitter

- 1. Head to the 'compose new tweet' section.
- 2. Choose the add photo/video option.
- 3. Select GIF from where you have saved it on your computer.
- 4. Once loaded the GIF will appear below the text section.
- 5. Add text to your tweet and most importantly, <u>don't forget to add your fundraising page link</u>.
