Some interesting facts about your local air ambulance charity

London's Air Ambulance Charity was founded in 1989. To date we have treated over 43,000 critically injured people and attended most major incidents in London including the Grenfell Tower fire and London Bridge terror incident.

We have a 7.5 minutes average flight time and the helicopter can fly anywhere in London (inside the M25) within 11 minutes.

On average five seriously injured patients are treated every day by our team.

1,713 critically injured patients were treated by a senior doctor and paramedic team at the roadside in 2021. You can see our life-saving work across London in more detail via our **interactive Mission Map.**

We were the first air ambulance in the UK to:

- Carry a doctor on board at all times
- Provide a 24/7 service
- Administer anaesthetic on scene
- Administer blood transfusions
- Perform open heart surgery on scene
