TEA PARTY

Pick a date and time when you'll get the maximum number of friends, family or work colleagues involved.

COUNTDOWN TO LIFT OFF

Below are your first steps to help you get your tea party off the ground.



Save the date

Do you have a date in mind? Try and avoid any big sporting or social events so you can have as many guests as possible. If you want to recruit a helper or two, send them a save the date message to make sure they can come before you confirm anything else.



Pick a location

Where would you like to hold your tea party? Think about the number of guests you'd like to invite, possible weather scenarios and the facilities you'll need to prepare your tea and goodies.

Choose a theme

Whether you celebrate the coronation of King Charles III by holding a traditional garden tea party or hosting a teddy bear's picnic for younger guests, choosing a theme can help you plan your tea party event. Maybe you can combine with a special birthday or anniversary, or even host a coronation beach party, once summer has arrived of course!

What to serve

Cakes, sandwiches, snacks, tea, soft drinks – the options are endless! Homemade or shop-bought? BYO or treats provided? If you have a healthconscious audience how about a guilt-free tea party replacing white bread and scones for tasty wholemeal, bran or fruit muffins. You can slip fruit, veggies and dips in amongst all the cakes and biscuits.

No license is currently needed to sell food at a one-off event; however all food distributed or sold will need to comply with the Food Safety Act so please use common sense and prepare and store food in a safe and hygienic manner. Label the food to be on the safe side. People may be allergic to an ingredient. The **Food Standards Agency** has some good advice on selling food.



Spread the word

Once you have chosen your date and venue then you'll be ready to invite your guests. If you are using social media, email or WhatsApp you can download our Tea Party digital graphic or alternatively you can print out our handy poster. All resources can be found <u>here.</u>

CHARGE YOUR CUPS

Now it's time to think about how you'll raise those life-saving funds. Here are some ideas to create a stir and make your party a sweet success: Get your invites out early so your guests save the date1

TOP TIPS



Sell cakes and sandwiches

For large cakes, you could sell the whole plate or sell by the slice. Use the labels in this pack to show a suggested donation for your cupcakes, snacks and sandwiches.



Ask for donations

You can ask guests to make a donation to London's Air Ambulance Charity on the day, or set up an online fundraising page and share with people who cannot attend your party but would still like to support you. There is more information on the 'Lift off' page of <u>this booklet</u>.



Matched funding

If you are holding your tea party at work, ask your employer if they'll offer matched funding. They may match part or all of the money you and your colleagues raise.



Fun and games

Mix in some games or a quiz to your tea party and charge people to take part. It could be as simple as guess the weight of the cake, speed-decorating or pay to enter a team in a tea-themed quiz.



Hold a raffle auction or tombola

You could ask local businesses for donations of prizes or perhaps auction off promised pledged actions by your guests. Do you know anyone who is a master chef or who loves to spring clean?

FLIGHTS OF FUN AND FANCY

Why not raise some extra money and have some fun while you're at it. By including some games at your tea party, you can let your imagination take flight!

Guess the weight:

Get your guests to pay to guess the weight of a cake, weigh it at the end of the tea party and the person with the closest guess wins a prize.

Blind tea tasting:

Stock up on as many different types of tea as you can find and see how many your guests can recognise without being told what they are.

Tea quiz:

You could make up some tea-themed questions and ask your guests for a donation to enter your quiz. Make sure you have a tiebreaker question ready in case of a draw!

Tea cup treasure hunt:

Print and cut out a batch of our paper tea cups and hide them around your tea party venue. Give your guests a window of time to find as many as possible, with a prize for the person who finds the most.

Sugar cube tower:

Race against each other to balance a set number of sugar cubes on top of one another. Make it extra difficult by doing it while wearing rubber gloves!



Tea tray raffle:

Before your tea party starts write down the number of one of the squares on the tea tray raffle sheet in this pack and put the piece of paper in an envelope. During your tea party guests can make a donation to choose a square to write their name in.

Only one name per square remember! Once all the squares have a name in, open your envelope to reveal the winning square: whoever's name is written in that square wins!

The prize could be something donated by a local business, a cake to take home, or half the money donated to the Tea Tray Raffle with the other half going to London's Air Ambulance Charity.

Tea tray memory game:

A fun game for children. Put a set number of items on a tray and cover them with a tea towel. Lift the towel for a minute to give players a chance to memorise all the items on the tray. The challenge is to remember as many items as possible once they're covered again with the tea towel.

'I'm a little teapot' musical statues:

Another fun game for little ones. Push the furniture back, put your favourite music on, and get up and dance. When the music is paused everyone has to freeze in their best 'I'm a little teapot' pose. Anyone who accidently moves is out, and the last person left wins!
