We take special doctors and equipment to anywhere in London, helping someone when they need us most.

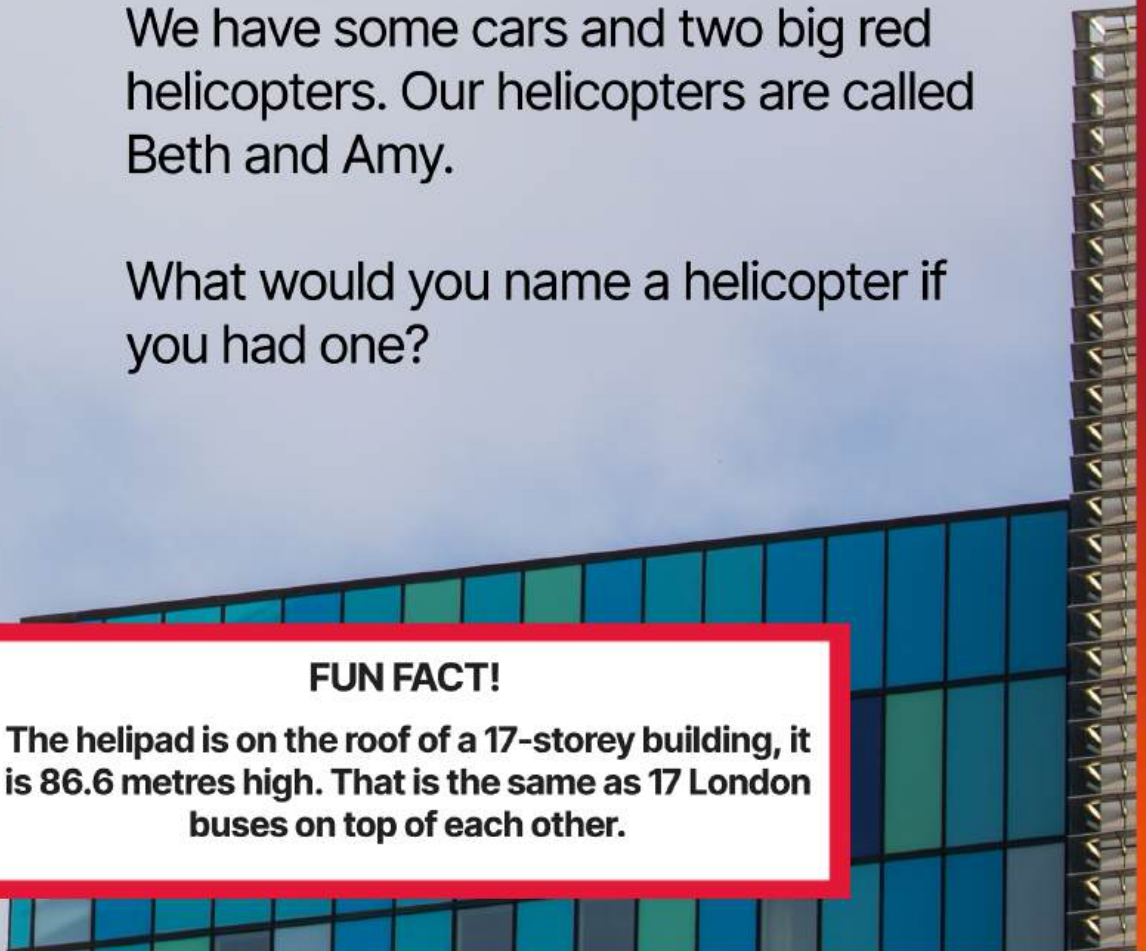
Our home is at The Royal London Hospital in Whitechapel.

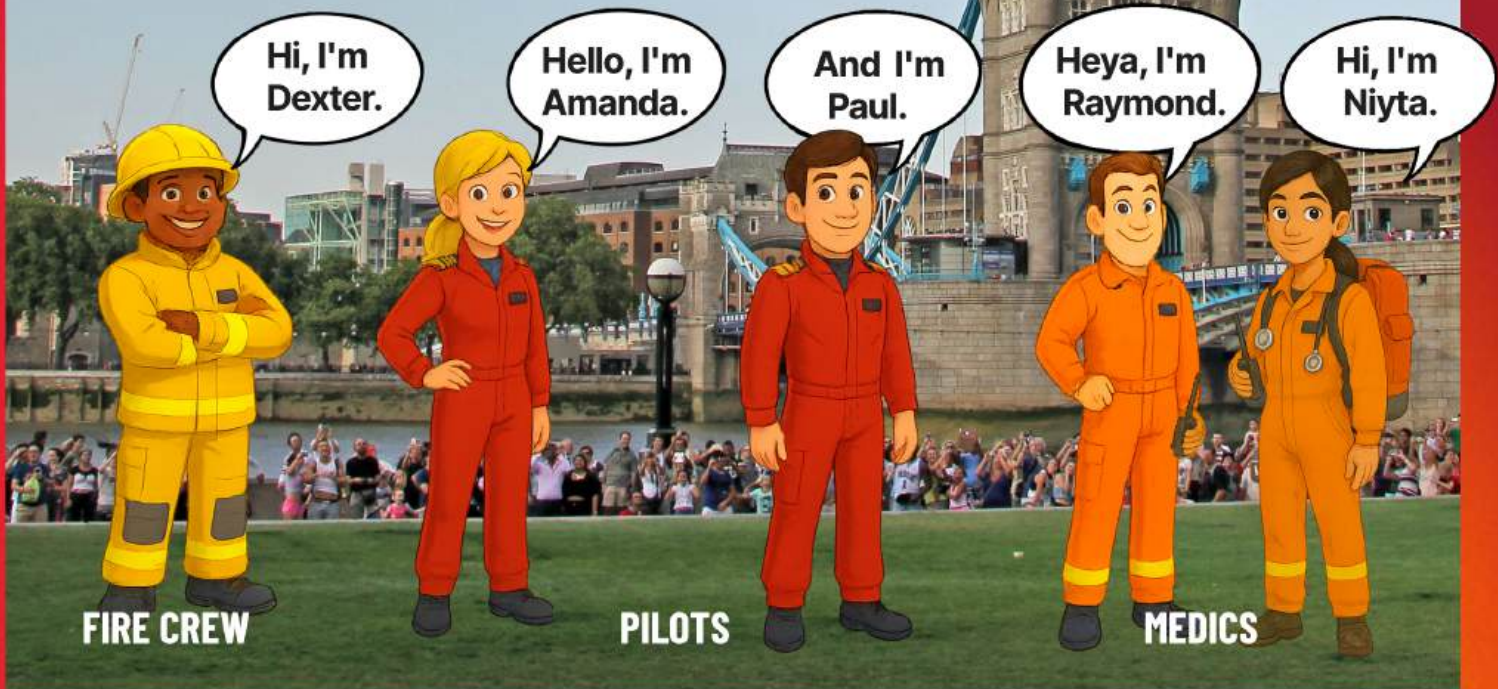
MEET OUR TEAM!

MEET OUR MEDICAL CREW

Our doctors and paramedics help people where an emergency happens – like at the side of the road. They can do special treatments that usually only happen in a hospital.

They carry all their important life-saving tools in bags that can fit in the back of our helicopter.

Our paramedics don't just fly in the helicopter, they also drive our fast response cars and work in the London Ambulance call centre, sending help to people who need it.

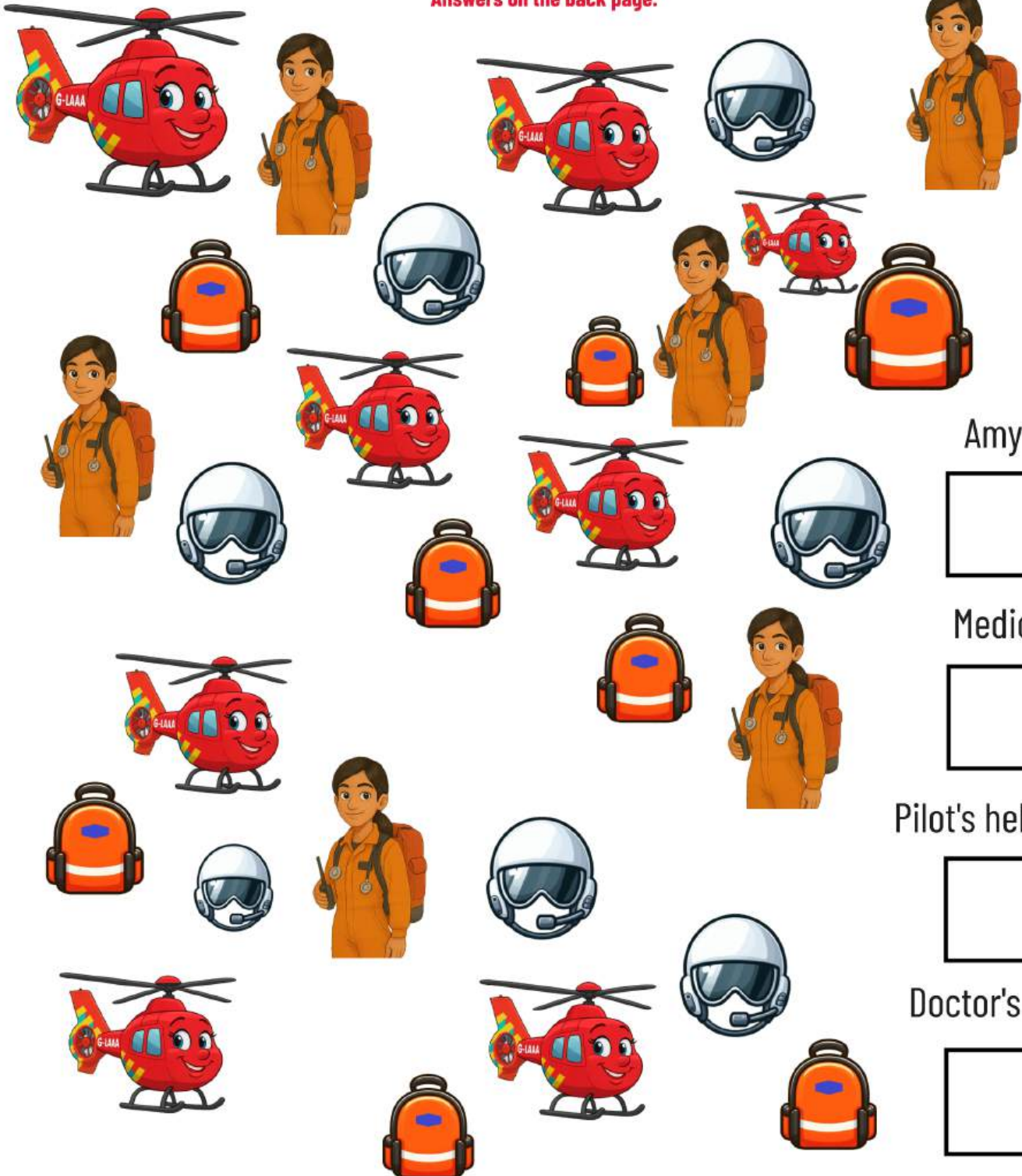

Rotor blades: The rotor blades spin very fast to lift the helicopter off the ground and into the air.

Cockpit: The cockpit is where the pilot and co-pilot sit to fly the helicopter and navigate their flight.

Landing skids: The helicopter uses landing skids as a flat surface to land on as it doesn't have wheels like a land ambulance would.

Cabin: There is lots of medical equipment on here. It is also where the doctor and paramedic sit.

MEET OUR FIRE CREW

Our fire crew are specially trained to help with helicopters. They make sure it's safe for the helicopter to take off and land.



They also keep an eye on the helicopter while it's flying to help someone, following it on a special map.

Our helicopter carries the same equipment you would find in a hospital emergency room, so the medics can carry out surgery anywhere in London.

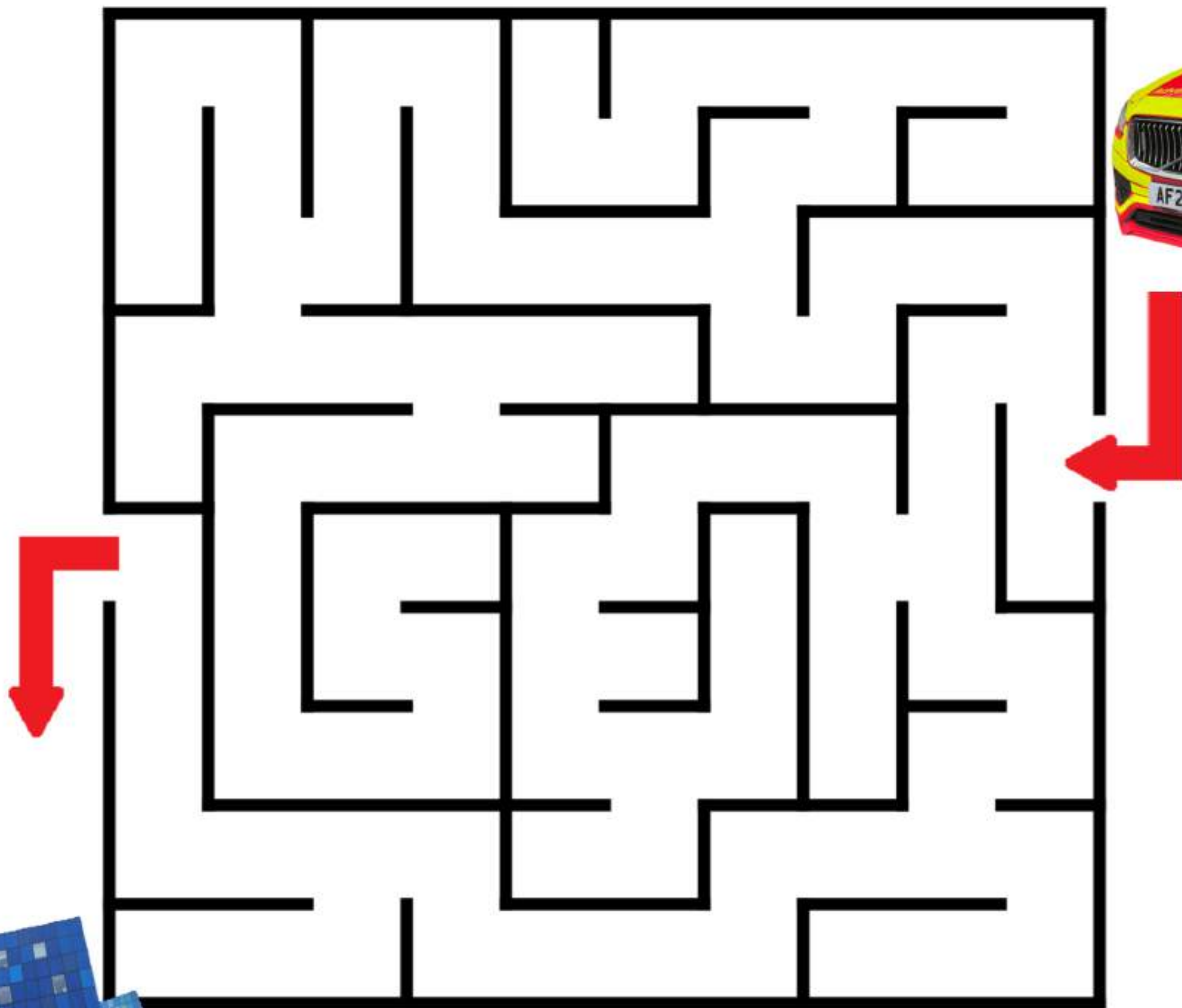

When you see our red helicopter in the sky it means someone needs our help. To help us reach them quickly even airplanes have to move out of our way!

Amy and Beth have a top speed of 157mph. That's the average speed of a Formula 1 car.



Our average flight time is just seven and a half minutes, and Amy and Beth can fly anywhere in London in under 11 minutes.

Our doctors and paramedics treat an average of six people per day.



On the bottom of our helicopters are the names of hundreds of people who helped to raise the money to buy Amy and Beth.
